Footnotes

CARTOUCHE led the second flight racing just off the inside from out of striking distance early, made steady progress on the far turn, bid three wide between foes nearing midstretch, gained a slight advantage from JACKS AGAIN and held that rival to the end under firm encouragement. The latter was pinched between foes at the start, angled to the rail to track behind the second flight, made a steady gain along the rail on the far turn, came around a tiring foe to bid inside the winner leaving midstretch and disputed the issue inside that foe to the end. FLY'N LION tracked the leaders along the inside as part of the second flight, shifted out on the far turn, clipped heels with the eventual winner near the quarter mile marker but continued with interest to split foes three wide nearing midstretch and gain a share. COUNTRY TOWN angled to the inside early, made solid progress racing to the far turn while shifting outside foes, raced five wide into upper stretch and improved his position to the end. JANSDREAM angled inwards to gain a position three deep in the second flight, made a brief bid four wide between foes leaving the far turn and flattened out in upper stretch. SICOMORO was urged to dispute the pace inside foes racing to the backstretch, couldn't match terms with the leaders after a half, chased that foe into the far turn, couldn't regain terms with that foe and gave way nearing midstretch. HEZA FLAMER, steadied in tight quarters soon after the start, settled off the inside and passed outside tiring rivals in the lane. GRAND ROW joined the pace three wide racing to the first turn, shook clear into the backstretch, held sway to midstretch and emptied out late. FLYING BY THE POLE drifted inwards into the path of HEZA FLAMER early, was settled outside foes and never gained contention. CLOUD CASTLE was never a factor. BABY MACK broke slowly and trailed throughout. HIPSTER ROYALTY stumbled at the start, briefly contested the pace between foes but stopped after a half.
