Footnotes

UPPERLINE joined a rival on the pace along the rail from the break, relinquished the lead to that foe entering the backstretch to stalk just off the pace, shifted out nearing the far turn while moving to regain terms with the leader, took over midway through the second bend, was allowed to drift out several paths leaving the quarter mile marker while under firm prompting to turn back a challenge from SNOW TOP MOUNTAIN and steadily drew away from that foe through the stretch while being kept to the task. The latter, moved to a contending position while angling inwards a bit racing four deep to the first turn, was reserved while angling over on that bend, made steady progress shifting nearer the inside after a half, switched out racing through the far turn to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch while gaining terms with the leader between calls, was floated a bit entering upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner in the last furlong but was clearly best of the others. DUNDALK DUST, shuffled back out of close quarters in the opening furlong, was settled off the inside to the backstretch, then continued three and four wide on the far turn to the stretch while improving her position to the end. CHANTILLY NAYLA broke sharply, prompted the pace outside a rival into the first turn, edged clear to a brief advantage on the backstretch, couldn't match terms with the winner after six furlongs and emptied out nearing midstretch. AGE OF HUMOR broke inwards bumping LAURA BABE at the start, was quickly righted to secure a tracking position just off the first flight racing three deep to the backstretch, made a brief bid in that path nearing the far turn but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. LAURA BABE, bumped at the start, was settled along the inside and never menaced thereafter.
