Footnotes

FAIRY CAT, in close attendance to the pace between foes, was eased off the first flight entering the bend to track those foes along the rail racing through the turn, shifted out three wide nearing upper stretch, took over and went well clear late under steady prompting. TEQUILA FACTOR joined the pace outside foes from the break, pressed the pace outside a rival into upper stretch, couldn't fend off the winner's bid but prevailed for place honors. BUDDY BE GOOD sped to the fore along the inside, dueled for command along the rail to upper stretch and weakened in the last furlong when failing to match the top pair. NELLA'S MANGAS tracked the leaders unhurried between foes racing into the bend, angled out four wide in upper stretch and made some mild progress. DAKOTA HIS DUE angled inwards to track the leaders outside a rival from just out of striking distance racing into the bend, shifted in nearing upper stretch but offered no closing bid. RUSSIAN STANDART was urged along racing inside foes in the last flight early to gain some position in the opening quarter but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. BRIMMERTON hopped at the start losing position to the field and never seriously menaced.
