LETHAL, forwardly placed along the inside tracking the pacesetter from just out of striking distance, steadily drew on terms with that foe nearing upper stretch, came through along the rail to wrest command in upper stretch and continued resolutely to hold safe the challenge of DESANI'S CHANCE under firm handling. The latter tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, loomed outside racing through the far turn, was carried out a bit by COUGAR'S SHADOW racing into upper stretch but continued with interest to close the gap late. FRANKLIN COUNTY, urged to contend from the outset, was carried out entering the first turn by LONGER VERSION, was collected, then shifted inside that foe while being urged to a contending position racing into the backstretch, couldn't menace the leaders but continued evenly into the stretch to gain a share. BROADLANDS settled along the inside early and made an effort to improve position between foes racing into the stretch. EL MOSCO settled along the inside in early stages, shifted out four deep racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. GRAND COMPOSER angled to the inside tracking the leaders racing just off the second flight in the opening half but offered no closing bid. COUGAR'S SHADOW was urged to the lead from between foes racing into the first turn, set the pace on a substantial margin racing into the far turn, drifted out nearing the quarter mile marker momentarily impeding a rival and quickly gave way. CHIEF CHICAGO worked his way to the inside while settling into stride but never mounted a serious challenge. BOXEO settled between foes in early stages and never seriously menaced. JAGWIRED made his way to the way inside early while being urged to contend racing into the backstretch but steadily faded entering the far turn. BARANIT, restless in the gate, threw his head at the start, dropped off the field in the opening stages and never menaced thereafter. LONGER VERSION, urged along three deep to gain a forward placing, bore out racing into the first turn impeding a rival and soon

dropped out of contention.
