CANTONIC was urged to the lead along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on his own courage into the second bend, then turned back several challengers racing into the stretch to resolutely prevail. BIG BAD MIKE settled off the second flight outside foes, advanced to contention four wide on the second bend, was fanned six wide racing through the stretch but continued with interest to just miss. MISTER THAYER settled along the inside early, saved ground racing into upper stretch and made steady progress late while shifting off the inside to gain a share. EIGHTY MILLION, bumped, then forced

into the path of SAM OWEN at the start, was settled in hand between foes, shifted out on the far turn to race three deep between foes, continued willingly five deep between foes into the stretch but was outkicked in the closing stages. WISTFUL SMILE, reserved between foes in the last flight early, swung out seven wide racing into upper stretch and continued willingly to close the gap. SAM OWEN, bumped at the start, was righted to gain a position in the second flight while pulling a bit along the inside, shifted outside the leaders to challenge entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. HUCKLEBERRY BOY broke inwards bumping EIGHTY MILLION, was quickly righted to gain a forward placing, moved to force the issue outside the pacesetter racing through the far turn into upper stretch but gave way when proving no match in late stages. RULER OF THE COURT tracked the leaders unhurried along rail, saved ground to upper stretch gaining some position but lacked the needed late response. L'AIGLON, urged to contend outside foes from the outset, made a brief bid three deep racing into the far turn but steadily retreated in the drive. GAGE PARK tracked the pace between foes off the second flight racing to the far turn but steadily faded entering upper stretch. BLUE CANOE trailed the field to the stretch. GAVILAN was a brief factor three deep racing in second flight in the opening half but gave way abruptly racing through the far turn.
