Footnotes

TRIPLE CHECK, reserved in hand outside a rival in the opening stages, shifted off the inside entering the backstretch while continuing under reserve, steadily drew into striking distance on the far turn, was urged to challenge three deep between foes racing into upper stretch while exchanging some light contact with ROI LE ROY but responded to firm right handed pressure to wrest command and hold safe the challenge of TACTICS SCHOOL to the end. The latter, held up along the inside racing as part of the second flight in the opening half, awaited an opening while losing some position in traffic nearing upper stretch, split foes near the inside approaching midstretch to challenge just inside the winner to the end but couldn't quite gain even terms with that foe. LOYA BIGTIME, reserved along the inside in last in the opening half, shifted out four wide on the backstretch, commenced an early move to press the issue three wide on the far turn, gained a clear advantage racing into upper stretch while shifting to the inside but couldn't sustain his momentum nor fend off the top pair. ROI LE ROY tracked the pace unhurried off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted out on the far turn to challenge four deep nearing upper stretch while being brushed by the winner but lacked the needed final kick. FULL FLAME tracked the pacesetter three deep in the second flight under some reserve in the opening stages, shifted inwards to make a brief bid between foes racing into the far turn but emptied out entering upper stretch. FIRST TRUMPET shifted outwards after the start bumping LANSING BLUE, was urged clear racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a clear margin to the second bend, briefly disputed the lead inside foes on the far turn but emptied out abruptly after six furlongs. LANSING BLUE, bumped just after the start, gained a position between foes in the second flight, was steadied a bit nearing the backstretch, continued in hand while dropping out racing into the far turn, was pulled up leaving midstretch, then was vanned off the course.
