JULIET TANGO, reserved between foes in the second flight while racing just out of striking distance in the opening half, shifted out three deep nearing upper stretch commencing her advance and produced a sustained response to reel in LOVE THIS KITTEN in time under strong handling. The latter tracked just off the leaders a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, made steady progress entering the far turn to challenge three deep midway through the bend, wrested command leaving midstretch to gain a clear advantage, resisted the winner's bid to the end but just failed to contain that foe. STARRY EYED KATE settled into stride while being guided to the inside, raced unhurried to the second bend, switched out to split foes three deep entering upper stretch and continued to make a steady effort to improve position while earning a share. SANTINA DOND was urged to the lead from the outset, set the pace into the far turn, dueled for command past midstretch but gave way late. SHES GOT TO RUN settled outside foes racing to the backstretch, was caught four wide on the far turn and had no closing bid. MUNDY tracked the leaders along the inside as part of the second flight while under some rating in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch but steadily faded in the drive. SWEET HARP, forwardly placed tracking just off the pacesetter, briefly challenged the leader between foes racing into the far turn but came up empty nearing upper stretch.
