Footnotes

COUNCIL OAK joined the pace along the inside from the break, shook clear of a drifting rival entering the turn, then steadily widened his advantage in a ridden out effort. DEACON PAPA PETE raced just off the leaders along the inside, shifted just off the rail to briefly challenge the winner nearing upper stretch, couldn't match that foe but held well for second. THERION threw his head at the start, recovered to gain terms with the second flight along the inside entering the turn, saved ground to upper stretch and improved his position. STEPFATHER tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight, continued three deep in that position to upper stretch but offered no closing bid. R T'S BLACK CAT broke outwards bumping IL FORO, was guided to the inside in the opening stages and continued evenly. SMOKE N ASPHALT ducked out at the start, was collected to track outside foes, was caught four wide racing into the turn and never seriously menaced. IL FORO hopped in the air at the start, was righted to track the pace three wide between foes racing to the turn but emptied out early. FIESTY KNIGHT flashed brief pace outside the eventual winner, bore out racing into the turn and was taken in hand while dropping well behind his foes.
