Footnotes

TAWAARED went readily to the fore along the rail, dictated the pace on a clear margin into the far turn and held sway to the end under firm pressure. MATAI, held up out of striking distance near the inside in the opening half, swung four wide leaving the far turn and proved best of the others. COOL C NOTE tracked just off and outside the leaders to the backstretch, moved to challenge three deep after six furlongs, couldn't match the top pair late but finished evenly for a share. NORMANDRUTH, off slowly and a step slow into stride, settled near the inside, shifted just off the rail nearing upper stretch to split foes and improved his position with a belated effort. STORM GALILEO was settled along the inside early and never mounted a serious challenge. SNAKE RIVER CANYON angled inwards to track just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. YEP trailed the field to the stretch. SNAPPED broke through the gate before the start, was pulling his rider racing inside the first flight in the opening half and dropped out abruptly nearing upper stretch.
