Footnotes

STELLAR PRIZE moved clear of her foes racing into the first turn while angling to the inside, dictated a comfortable pace while in hand racing to the second bend, was urged to turn back a challenger midway through the far turn to regain a clear advantage in upper stretch and made the balance of the pace under firm encouragement. TONZIE tracked the pacesetter three wide in second flight racing to the backstretch, advanced on the leader to force the issue midway through the far turn but proved no match in late stages while being bumped nearing the wire by FINE LOOKIN LADY but held for place honors. FINE LOOKIN LADY settled into stride along the inside tracking off the second flight in the opening half, made steady progress along the rail racing into upper stretch, then shifted out in the final stages while steadily closing the gap and made some contact with TONZIE while just missing for second. ALLEGORY tracked the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight early, shifted out three wide on the far turn while being prompted to advance, continued in that path to upper stretch and finished evenly late. MISS KITTEN settled outside foes off the second flight racing to the backstretch and never gained striking distance. LAKE SHORE GRACE angled inwards to lead the second flight between foes while under some pressure to maintain striking distance and gave way racing through the far turn.
