DREAMSPELL broke readily to gain terms with a rival on the pace in the opening stages, shifted off the inside nearing the backstretch while dropping off the leaders a bit racing under light rating, switched back to the inside before a half gaining position in the second flight, came through some close quarters on the second bend while bumped from behind, shifted out three wide in upper stretch and continued with a solid late response to wrest a narrow advantage in time under steady handling. DREAMS DIE FIRST, reserved from just out of striking distance while shifting outside foes racing to the backstretch, continued with a steady bid on the far turn to challenge the pacesetter entering upper stretch, struck the front in late stages but just failed to contain the winner. MONONO, rank fighting restraint in the opening stages, shifted outside foes while pulling her way to the lead racing to the backstretch, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the second bend, disputed the issue inside a rival racing into upper stretch but yielded to the top pair in late stages. APPELLA'S WONDER settled in last along the inside racing through the backstretch, came through close quarters to challenge inside foes on the far turn while making some contact with the eventual winner while also bumping the rail, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch and lacked the needed final response. TIME COUNTS was prompted to gain a forward placing between foes racing into the first turn, relinquished the lead nearing the backstretch to track that rival between foes to the second bend but steadily faded nearing upper stretch.
