Total earnings in 2002 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight (on the scale). In the event this stake race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee.

CETEWAYO lacked speed while saving ground, was allowed to settle to the stretch, came out four wide for the drive, rallied through the lane and was along in the final strides. PRIVATE SON raced inside near the middle of the field, remained inside to the stretch, found room on the rail to make his bid in the stretch and took the lead between calls in deep stretch but just failed to last. PISCES found good position close up and away from the rail, remained in good position to the stretch and responded when asked for his best but lacked a winning bid. RIDDLESDOWN (IRE) was allowed to open an easy lead away from the gate, set all of the pace from the inside while clear, remained clear near the furlong marker then weakened a bit late. BAHROBA raced near the middle of the field in the early going, dropped back to trail to the stretch, angled out for the drive and rallied belatedly. RED MOUNTAIN was void of early speed, angled out four wide for the drive and loomed a mild threat but flattened out. TWO POINT TWO MILL lacked speed four wide, was always outrun and was vanned off after the race. CLASSIC PAR raced near the middle of the field and gave way after a mile. RED ANTICS stalked the pace just outside and tired.
