FOR FILLIES, THREE-YEARS-OLD. Nominations close on Saturday, June 28, 2003 with no fee. \$150 to pass the entry box and an additional \$150 to start, with \$45,000 Added of which 60% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHT: 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 at one mile or over in 2003, allowed 2 lbs.; \$28,000 once at one mile or over since December 1, 2002, allowed 4 lbs.; \$24,000 at any distance since October 1, 2002, 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starters races not considered in estimating allowances.) The field will be limited to twelve (12) starters; Highweights on the scale preferred. Total Earnings in 2003 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight (on the scale).

AUD lacked speed off the rail, rallied in the stretch and was up in the final strides. CAT'S CAT set the pace from the inside and resisted gamely but could not last. U K TRICK was forced to take up on the first turn, angled off the rail and rallied but missed. SHOT GUN FAVORITE raced close up without a rally. BEGIN THE BEGUINE was never a factor. BAYANI lacked speed and showed little. BAKEWELL TART (IRE) was always outrun. COMBAT SOLDIER pressed the pace from just outside and tired.
