Footnotes

LIMESTONE gained a position outside foes tracking the leaders in second flight from just out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, continued inside a rival in that fashion into the second bend, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch while being roused to advance and made sharp progress in the final stages to just edge POWERSFIELD in time under firm encouragement. The latter, forwardly placed tracking the pacesetter in the opening half, shifted out three deep nearing upper stretch to bid for command in tandem with a rival, struck the front between calls late and just failed to contain the winner. FUN ON THE BAYOU, off last, made steady progress near the inside after a half to advance on the leaders, moved to challenge in tandem with a rival nearing upper stretch and was just outkicked by the top pair. RUN RIGHT AT IT urged clear racing into the first turn, dictated the pace to upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum through the final furlong. AFLEET PADDY settled outside foes in the opening stages, made brief progress three deep to gain contention on the far turn but had no closing bid. CREATIVE WIZARD, held up between foes off the second flight in early stages, shifted out four wide on the backstretch and soon faded from contention. IRON CHAMP, reserved off the second flight along the inside racing into the first turn, dropped out of contention early.
