ICE CLIMBER, reserved in last racing to the far turn, gradually drew into contention splitting foes just off the inside racing into upper stretch and produced a solid late response to wrest command from BWANA BRAVE in time under firm left handed encouragement. The latter pulled his way to terms with a rival on the pace racing to the first turn, attended the pace outside that foe to the second bend, moved to gain the advantage nearing upper stretch, went clear nearing the furlong marker but couldn't quite fend off the winner. PRAIRIE BREEZE, reserved off the second flight saving ground to the backstretch, continued inside rivals on the far turn, was shuffled a bit in traffic entering upper stretch, but continued willingly between foes to the end to prevail for a share while closing the gap on the top pair. WHERE'S THE BABY, three deep in second flight in the opening stages, was taken back from that position to track the pace outside a rival to the second bend, shifted four wide nearing upper stretch, was fanned five wide entering the lane but continued with interest to make mild progress to the end. FRIENDLY BANTER moved to the lead along the rail to dictate the pace on a narrow margin under rating, continued in that fashion to the far turn, was roused to repel several challengers racing into the stretch but weakened in late stages. MONASTIC, pulling against restraint in the opening stages, was guided to the inside to track the leaders in second flight racing to the far turn, swung out four wide entering upper stretch while being urged to advance but lacked the needed final kick. SNAPPED tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight in the opening half, shifted out on the second bend to lodge a brief, three wide bid but quickly emptied out in the drive.
