HAPPY COOPER ducked inwards at the start crossing the paths of GLENCO KID and KITCHI WARRIOR, took up a position just off the pacesetter along the rail stalking that foe racing into the bend, briefly awaited an opening entering upper stretch, then shifted out with a sharp move in the final sixteenth to challenge three deep and surged to command in time under firm handling. TOO MUCH TALK was urged to gain terms with a rival on the pace, prompted that foe racing into the bend, wrested command nearing the sixteenth marker but couldn't quite contain the winner. RAVIN ABOUT RIV broke inwards bumping J EVANS, was quickly righted to secure the lead along the rail, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum through the last furlong. GLENCO KID broke a step slowly, then was checked out of tight quarters at the start, continued with a steady effort to regain contention racing into upper stretch splitting rivals but lacked the needed final kick. OVERSTOCK ALERT, urged along outside a rival racing as part of the second flight racing into the turn, moved to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. KITCHI WARRIOR was steadied out of tight quarters while nearest the rail in the opening stages, settled into stride along the inside, swung six wide entering upper stretch but never gained contention. J EVANS, bumped at the start, was collected, then guided to the inside to track off the second flight racing into the turn, shifted out in traffic entering upper stretch and dropped into last while racing five wide between foes late.
