Footnotes

EMILE, forwardly placed stalking the pacesetter in the opening stages, continued with steady bid to wrest command racing into upper stretch, went clear under pressure racing through the lane and was taken in hand late once the issue was decided. ISLE OF SKYE, urged to the lead along the inside in the opening stages, dueled for command into upper stretch but couldn't match terms with the winner. DOIMAKEYAHAPPY, off a step slowly, was urged to gain a position along the inside tracking just off the leaders while racing in some close quarters nearing the turn, shifted off the inside racing into upper stretch while being roused to challenge but had no closing bid. HELOOKSTHEPART, reserved in last near the inside in the opening quarter, shifted outside foes racing into the turn and made an effort to improve position four wide in late stages. KIPLING'S KING tracked off the second flight three deep between foes, was steadied slightly in tight quarters nearing the turn and offered no rally. MY CONTENDER, slow into stride, was urged to contend while shifting inwards nearing the turn but emptied out early.
