HAPPY HENRIETTA, in touch with the pacesetter from the outset, stalked just off the foe under firm rating racing to the far turn, was urged to challenge, then roused right handed nearing midstretch and produced a solid late response to narrowly prevail in time under firm handling. DELIGHTFUL DAISY broke inwards brushing DOCTOR CARINA, readily moved to the fore along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace under rating into the second bend, resisted the winner's bid past midstretch and just failed to contain that rival. DOCTOR CARINA, brushed at the start, was held up off the first flight tracking the leaders outside a rival, shifted three deep on the backstretch, continued in that path to challenge after six furlongs but lacked the needed final response while continuing well enough to prevail for a share. HEART THIEF, unhurried along the inside tracking off the second flight in the opening half, shifted off the inside to split foes racing through the far turn, shifted four wide advancing between foes in upper stretch and made some mild progress in that path to the end. HELLO AGAIN, reserved outside a rival racing off the second flight racing to the far turn, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch but finished evenly in the last furlong. MONSTRIP bobbed at the start, gained a tracking position just off the leaders along the inside racing to the backstretch, continued to save ground on the second bend but steadily weakened in the drive. JAZZ ODYSSEY was settled along the inside in the opening half, shifted outside foes on the far turn, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch but offered no rally.
