Footnotes

SO LONG JULIE was reserved just off the first flight three deep between foes in the opening stages, angled in nearing the turn while continuing under light rating, steadily advanced to striking position splitting foes just off the inside nearing upper stretch, continued with a steady response to wrest command from BARI'S PULPETTE leaving the furlong marker and drew away late under firm encouragement. The latter raced in close attendance to the pace outside foes under light rating early, moved to challenge for command entering the bend while being fanned four wide, came around foes to gain the advantage racing into upper stretch but couldn't match the winner in the last furlong. CHOCOLATE LATTE, within striking distance from the outset, stalked the pacesetter between foes in the opening stages, advanced to press the issue between rivals on the turn but couldn't match the top pair in the final quarter. ARGUE THE TOSS broke outwards making some contact with SPECIALAGENTNCHARG, was reserved inside that foe on the backstretch, angled five wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to to improve position. USEFUL BERRY tracked off and outside the first flight under light rating early, was caught five wide entering the turn, then steadily faded from contention. SPECIALAGENTNCHARG, bumped, then steadied a bit at the start, lost position to the leaders and never regained contention. ZORJA broke awkwardly while dropping well off the leaders, was urged to regain contention while splitting foes just off the inside racing into the turn, struck the front approaching the three furlong marker and quickly emptied out. SLIGO BREEZE sped to the fore along the inside while shifting inwards a bit at the gap, set the pace to the turn and emptied out abruptly once she was headed.
