Footnotes

ESPRESSO was settled out of striking distance along the inside in the opening stages, gained some momentum while shifting out to advance between foes near the inside entering the bend, was steadied off a tiring foe midway through the turn, continued with interest along the inside into the stretch, then found a seam nearing the furlong marker to split foes and wrest command late. GIBBY'S TORNADO tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, shifted outside a tiring foe to bid between rivals nearing upper stretch, gained the advantage leaving the furlong marker but couldn't fend off the winner. OUTLINE, shuffled a bit at the start, tracked off the second flight outside foes, split foes three deep racing into upper stretch and continued well enough to prevail for a share. VAN DEMON went up to force the pace outside a rival from the break, shook clear racing into the turn but emptied out nearing the furlong marker. ABACO STORM settled outside foes off the second flight early, was caught five wide while being urged to contention nearing upper stretch and lacked a closing response while exchanging repeated contact with ARCTIC POINT in the closing stages. ARCTIC POINT tracked off the second

flight outside foes in early stages, made some progress four deep on the bend, drifted out entering upper stretch exchanging repeated contact with ABACO STORM and had no further response. STRONG LUCK exchanged bumps with SAINT MUSKET at the start, was righted to lead the second flight from just out of striking distance racing to the bend, moved to briefly challenge the pacesetter between foes three deep on the bend but flattened out in the drive. WILDWOOD ARAGORN shifted well off the inside in early stages but never gained contention. CUARTO CUATES broke awkwardly, worked his way to the inside racing into the bend and never menaced. SAINT MUSKET exchanged bumps at the start, was pulling along the inside while briefly disputing the pace, emptied out abruptly entering the turn, then was steadied midway through the bend losing all momentum.
