Footnotes

LET'S CALL A TRUCE, reserved in last along the inside for the opening six furlongs, steadily gathered momentum near the inside approaching upper stretch, swung out with a sharp move to challenge five wide racing through upper stretch and produced a steady late response to gain the advantage in time under firm handling. MEC DANCER settled out of striking distance along the inside in the opening half, shifted out nearing upper stretch to bid four wide between foes racing through the lane and was just outkicked while prevailing for place honors. EXIT moved to the fore along the rail to dictate the pace on a narrow margin into the backstretch, continued in that fashion though the second bend, was urged clear in upper stretch but couldn't quite fend off the top pair. HE'S GOT TO RUN, caught four wide racing into the first turn while gaining position in the second flight, continued with a steady three wide advance racing into the far turn to challenge the leader entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. BOSS ALLEY, reserved off the second flight near the inside racing to the far turn, shifted out to split foes just off the rail racing into upper stretch but finished in hand when caught in close quarters late. WILD JAZ, held up along the inside tracking just off the first flight, came through close quarters to bid inside foes racing into upper stretch but had no final kick. PIRALU tracked just off the first flight between foes under light rating in the opening half, shifted out on the far turn while being prompted to advance but quickly came up empty leaving the far turn. FEODOR was settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. PRICELESS SHORE gained terms with a rival attending that foe's pace in the opening stages, pressed the issue between foes racing through the far turn and emptied out abruptly entering the lane.
