SHOT THE DEPUTY raced five wide near the middle of the field and gained belatedly. INDIAN SUMMER DAY contested the pace from off the rail and weakened. BELIEVABLE NEMO saved ground but lacked a rally. EVERWHAT raced four wide but was never a factor. JUDGE PERKINS vied for the lead inside and tired. JOHN MORGAN lacked speed and failed to reach contention. CASUAL CASH was always outrun. OUR MEMENTO was also outrun.
