PRETTY SLIC CHICK broke sharply, moved clear while angling over to the inside, dictated the pace under rating into the bend, responded when roused in upper stretch and steadily widened her advantage. YOU'RE OUTTA HERE angled inwards gaining a tracking position just off the pacesetter, couldn't gain terms with that foe entering upper stretch but held well for the place. RIO RITA broke inwards brushing WINPINS, was reserved off foes while making her way to the inside, shifted out in upper stretch, then came through close quarters splitting foes near midstretch to gain a share. WINPINS broke awkwardly, was bumped by LIVE TODAY, shifted outside foes tracking the pace unhurried, was fanned five wide entering upper stretch and made an effort to improve her placing. KITTY CITY tracked the leaders three wide in second flight, made a brief bid nearing upper stretch but soon flattened out. LET IT RAIN tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail, saved ground to upper stretch but came up empty in the drive. LIVE TODAY broke outwards bumping WINPINS, was righted to track the leaders between rivals in second flight but faded in late stages after failing to produce a closing response.
