TELLME ALL ABOUTIT broke very sharply and to a clear advantage, dictated the pace inside foes racing into the bend, then edged clear in the final furlong while being kept to steady pressure. INSIDE DEAL tracked the leaders as part of the second flight along the rail racing to the bend, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch and continued with interest to split foes while prevailing for the place. FISCAL POLICY ducked out at the start, was quickly righted to prompt the pacesetter racing into the bend while angling inwards, drifted inwards leaving the furlong marker when failing to match terms with that foe and lost the place late. PUT AND TAKE, moved quickly to gain terms with the leaders while angling inwards in the opening stages, switched out on the bend to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch, drifted out nearing midstretch while failing to match terms with the winner and gave way. LADY BLUEGRASS, reserved along the inside in the opening quarter, angled out four deep entering upper stretch and displayed some belated interest. HOLY HEAVENS bobbled after the start, was quickly collected to track the leaders between foes in second flight racing to the bend but had no closing bid. CREPE MYRTLE tracked the leaders three wide in second flight racing to the turn but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. BELLA COUTURE, a bit outpaced in early stages, offered no rally.
