### Footnotes

STRONG APPEAL shifted off the inside in the opening stages while gaining a position to track the leaders from just out of striking distance in the opening half, steadily drew into contention between foes on the bend while continuing in hand, split foes three deep entering upper stretch and responded to firm right handed pressure to prevail nearing the wire. LEMON CUSTARD worked his way to the inside racing through the backstretch while gaining a position in the second flight, made steady progress nearest the rail while bobbling a bit nearing the quarter mile marker but continued willingly inside foes to challenge for command racing through the stretch while not quite matching terms with the winner. TUCKY, reserved along the inside in the opening half, continued to save ground on the bend, angled out four wide entering upper stretch and was making steady progress to the end to close the gap and gain a share. HURTA was urged to secure the lead while shifting off the inside in the opening quarter, set the pace on a clear margin into upper stretch racing just off the inside but failed to sustain his momentum through the final furlong. PEYTONVILLE tracked the pace outside foes off the second flight in early stages, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. GOLD LEGION settled into stride near the inside in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge. STEALTH HERO broke readily to gain a clear advantage, relinquished the lead nearing the six furlong marker, stalked just off and outside the pacesetter racing into the bend and emptied out entering upper stretch.
