HOT KITTEN broke sharply, was taken in hand while being guided to the rail to lead the second flight into the backstretch from just out of striking distance, made a steady advance inside foes on the far turn, shifted out to split rivals near the three sixteenth marker challenging for command, then edged forward in the final furlong under firm right handed prompting. CATALINA WAY was urged to secure a narrow advantage along the rail racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a comfortable tempo into the second bend, resisted the winner past the furlong marker but came up second best. CRIMSON DOON, forwardly placed between foes from the outset, attended the pace to the second bend, then continued willingly three deep through the stretch while just outkicked by the top pair. CAT BELLS tracked the pace between foes in the second flight under rating to the far turn, shifted to the inside to lodge her bid entering upper stretch and was making mild progress to the end. A. J.'S LOVE tracked the pace three deep off the second flight under reserve in the opening half, angled out nearing upper stretch and made an effort to improve her position four deep between foes to late stages. THE BEST OPTION settled into stride while making her way to the inside racing well off the leaders, saved ground on the far turn and continued inside foes racing through the stretch while making some belated progress. PHALEONOPSIS, reserved off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn, shifted out six wide racing into upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. ARMS RACE tracked the leaders unhurried three deep in the second flight racing to the far turn, then continued evenly between foes to late stages. HONORED VIEW, held up between foes off the second flight in the opening half, continued between foes near the inside into upper stretch, steadied a bit in close quarters near the furlong marker and offered no rally. MULATA, a bit slow into stride, raced unhurried to the

backstretch, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch but offered no rally. SUMMER COURTSHIP, forwardly placed four, then three wide racing to the backstretch, moved to press the issue in that path entering the far turn, drifted out entering upper stretch and steadily faded from contention.
