**Footnotes**

CLOCKER BOB broke sharply to gain a clear advantage, angled to the inside dictating the pace on a clear margin racing into the bend, drew clear in upper stretch and was kept to steady pressure to maintain his advantage. TENSAW, held up a bit when exchanging contact with ENERGETIC SREVA in the opening furlong, tracked unhurried between foes near the inside racing to the bend, shifted out midway through the turn to challenge five wide after a half, ducked inwards cutting off several rivals entering upper stretch but continued with interest to prove best of the others. ENERGETIC SREVA, took a few erratic steps when exchanging contact with TENSAW in the opening furlong, continued unhurried along the inside racing to the bend, was steadied in traffic along the rail midway through the turn, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch, steadied again when losing his path near the three sixteenths marker but continued willingly along the inside to late stages to improve position and gain a share. AMRAM, urged to position inside foes tracking the pacesetter in the opening stages, continued to make some progress chasing the leader on the rail through the turn but gave way nearing midstretch. COOL PREN, bumped by FREE TICKET at the start, settled into stride, shifted off the inside entering upper stretch and made an effort to improve his position four wide in late stages. CROFTER, close up between foes in the opening quarter, dropped off the second flight nearing the bend while shifting to the outside, made some progress while angling four wide nearing upper stretch, then lost all momentum when shut off nearing the three sixteenth marker by TENSAW. DOCKTOR DEMENTED, off a step slowly, shifted outside foes in the opening stages avoiding some traffic, was caught four wide racing into the turn but offered no closing bid. FREE TICKET, bumped by BROKEANDBUSTED, then forced into the path of COOL PREN at the start, dropped out of contention while racing

wide into the turn and never menaced thereafter. BROKEANDBUSTED swerved outwards bumping a rival, was righted to chase the pacesetter three wide between foes into the bend and gave way after a half. PARODY chased the pacesetter racing four wide into the turn and gave way after a half.
