### Footnotes

BRIDGETTE BORDEAUX gained a position tracking just off the first flight outside a rival racing into the bend, continued with a steady advance racing four, then three deep nearing upper stretch to challenge, wrested command nearing the sixteenth marker and pulled clear late under firm left handed encouragement. JEWELIA ANNE, bumped at the start, was urged along to gain contention racing into the turn, split foes midway through the bend to challenge the pacesetter, wrested brief command racing into upper stretch but couldn't fend off the winner late. SEATTLE TRAIN broke inwards bumping JEWELIA ANNE, was collected off that foe then settled into stride along the inside, split foes three deep nearing upper stretch, shifted four wide entering the lane and continued willingly to gain position to the end while earning a share. PELIGROSA settled out of striking distance along the rail racing into the turn, came around a tiring foe entering upper stretch and steadily improved her position along the inside racing through the stretch. INDYGO KISS tracked the leaders from out of striking distance outside a rival racing into the bend and lacked a closing response. SALLY BEMO was urged to join the pace outside a rival racing to the turn and gave way after a half. C'MON FEET settled outside foes in the last flight early and never seriously menaced. MAGDALENKA sped to the fore along the inside from the break, set the pace into the turn and emptied out abruptly entering upper stretch.
