Footnotes

ULTIMO TRAGO broke inwards making some contact with STAR OF CLASS, was righted to secure terms with a rival on the pace racing nearest the rail, moved to press the pace inside that foe on the turn, forged clear in upper stretch and was given some right handed pressure to extend the advantage. LASSELL, urged along three deep in pursuit of the leaders racing into the the turn, shifted to the rail entering upper stretch and continued with interest to prove best of the others while no threat to the winner. RICHIE'S LIFESTYLE bobbed at the start, was quickly collected then hustled to the lead outside a rival, forced the pace racing into the bend and gave way in upper stretch when failing to match that rival. STAR OF CLASS, bumped at the start, tracked the leaders from out of striking distance along the inside to upper stretch and continued evenly along the rail to late stages. ANIMAL HOUR settled into stride along the inside on the backstretch, shifted out in upper stretch while being prompted to gain some position but made no impression on the leaders. WICENTY settled between foes in the opening stages, angled outside foes racing through the turn but lacked the needed closing response. MISTER PADDY, off a bit slowly, was urged outside foes racing through the backstretch but soon trailed.
