Footnotes

CONTROL TOWER, reserved well off the second flight while shifting nearer to the inside racing to the backstretch, continued unhurried to the second bend, angled five wide racing into upper stretch while steadily advancing on the leaders, then responded when prompted to take charge and draw clear under firm encouragement. ZIPPIDY DO HAH, reserved off the second flight outside a rival racing to the backstretch, moved to challenge the leaders while shifting out four wide entering upper stretch, continued with a solid kick past the furlong marker but couldn't match terms with the winner. PETAK MOUNTAIN broke outwards bumping CLOUT, was settled along the inside racing well out of striking distance to the far turn, gathered momentum near the inside racing into the stretch, angled out six deep nearing the furlong marker and continued well enough to edge a rival for a share. DR BALLENGER broke awkwardly, moved to regain contention while shifting to the inside racing into the first turn, tracked off the second flight into the second bend, shifted out avoiding some traffic entering upper stretch to split foes three deep and continued with interest while being just outkicked for a share. SENATOR DAVE tracked just off the leader along the inside in second flight under light rating racing to the far turn, briefly awaited an opening while shifting off the inside racing into upper stretch, then continued four deep between foes in late stages while lacking the needed final response. BOSS ALLEY, reserved well out of striking distance

along the inside in the opening half, swung out nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed rally. EVENSUP gained a contending position three deep stalking just off the first flight racing to the backstretch, moved to challenge the leaders in that path nearing upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum through the last furlong. NO BULL JESS sped to the fore outside foes racing into the first turn, angled to the rail dictating the pace on a narrow margin to the second bend, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. CLOUT broke slowly, then was bumped just after the start and never gained contention. LITTLE KICK pulled his way to terms with a rival on the pace to attend the tempo for a half, dueled for command between foes into upper stretch and gave way.
