QUALITY DIPLOMAT broke readily to dispute the pace inside foes from the outset, edged forward nearing upper stretch, forged clear under pressure entering upper stretch and held sway to the end in a drive. SUNSHINE EXPRESS tracked the leaders out of striking distance off the second flight racing nearest the rail into the bend, saved ground to upper stretch and came through inside foes late to prove best of the others. GRUDGE MATCH tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight racing to the bend, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and continued with a mild bid while being outfinished for

place honors. NO LIP settled outside foes off the second flight racing into the turn, was fanned five wide entering upper stretch and continued evenly to late stages. HIP HOPPER tracked the pace between foes off the second flight racing into the turn, angled to the rail entering upper stretch but had no rally. TRIPLE OVERTIME, within striking distance in the opening stages, dropped off the first flight to track those foes while shifting to the inside racing into the turn but steadily faded entering upper stretch. SIDESPLITTING settled outside foes in the opening stages and never seriously menaced. SHERIFF MAX was settled into stride four wide between foes in the opening stages and dropped out early. STARK RAVIN MAD broke awkwardly, was urged gain terms with the pacesetter in the opening quarter, forced the pace racing into the turn and emptied out in upper stretch.
