NURSE LAURA was always close up but lacked a rally. BROKEN MOON improved her position in the drive. DOREMIFASOLASIDO raced outside, came six wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. NO NO PERDOMO lacked speed, made a run in the stretch and faltered. FIRST COVENANT was never a factor. FAMILIAR RING was outrun. COLORS IN THE SNOW set the pace inside while pressed and tired. CLASSIC TABLE raced close up inside and tired. LADY XENA trailed throughout.
