YOUNG SAGE was fractious in the post parade and was not a factor. SILKYENCE lacked speed and improved her position. MISS MIZZOU raced close up outside and tired. LUSTY KELLY raced near the middle of the field and gave way. BUCKLE UP CART was always outrun. IMA LITTLE ROSE was also outrun. BETTY'S GRAND BET trailed throughout.
