GENTLY set the pace from off the rail while pressed but could not hold off the winner. DEEP WOODS lacked speed off the rail and challenged in the stretch but was outfinished. MISS MERIT raced close up three wide and lacked a winning bid. SNOWBIRD checked a few strides out of the gate, lacked speed and improved her position. BOOK THE BULLET gave way in the drive. MYTHICAL EVENT pressed the pace from the inside and gave way. FRENCH ACCOUNT saved ground but was through early.
