Footnotes

MUSCA secured a stalking position soon after the break while making his way to the inside entering the first turn, switched out entering upper stretch to challenge, took over leaving the furlong marker and drew clear under steady pressure. SWAINS NEWS stalked the pacesetter within striking distance while in hand in the opening stages, moved to brief command leaving the far turn, couldn't fend off the winner but continued well enough to save second. AKA LILY'S LAD tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail from out of striking distance in the opening half, saved ground on the far turn while gaining some momentum, shifted out nearing the furlong marker to bid between foes and just missed the place. PAISANO CREEK broke awkwardly, was collected to advance to contention racing four wide on the backstretch, continued outside foes in that path to upper stretch but offered no closing bid. BADGER BO, broke a bit slowly, was reserved well off the pace along the inside to the backstretch, shifted outside leaving the far turn, raced five wide through the stretch but made no impression. CONSTABULARY tracked the pace unhurried between foes in the opening half and soon came up empty racing through the far turn. HOLD THAT BROAD sprinted clear of the field along the inside in the opening quarter, dictated the pace into the far turn and emptied out abruptly once headed.
