Footnotes

BANK ACCOUNT broke outwards brushing SHEDROW HERO, was righted to track just off the leaders between foes while racing in close quarters in the opening stages, angled inside entering the bend, shifted out in upper stretch, drew on terms with NAFIR'S LAD in late stages and narrowly prevailed under firm right handed encouragement. The latter dictated the pace outside a rival racing to the turn, moved clear on the bend, held sway to late stages and resisted the winner to the end. SHEDROW HERO, brushed at the start, was reserved outside foes in the opening stages while exchanging some contact with the eventual winner in the opening quarter, made steady progress racing three deep into upper stretch, couldn't match the top pair but edged a rival for a share. CAP'N MEDS was held up just off the pacesetter along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch and had no final kick. CANAVERAL RIDE stumbled at the start, was collected to chase the pacesetter from the outside for a half and gave way in upper stretch.
