Footnotes

FIRST GUESS, a bit restless in the gate prior to start, gained a contending position between foes soon after the break, was pushed out a bit in the opening quarter by RIGGAN racing just off the first flight, commenced a steady bid three deep entering the bend to gain striking distance entering upper stretch, continued in an extended skirmish for command racing past the furlong marker and prevailed in the final stages under firm left handed encouragement. AMAZING BUD broke sharply, switched immediately to the inside while crossing the paths of several foes, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the rail entering the bend, then grudgingly resisted the winner's bid to the end while proving only second best. WATTS FERRY, broke outwards exchanging contact with RIGGAN at the start, was steadied off AMAZING BUD when racing in close quarters nearing the five furlong marker, continued under some reserve along the inside racing into the turn, came through inside foes to gain some position entering upper stretch but had no final kick. DRIFTING WIND broke outwards bumping STORM CROSSED soundly, was collected off that foe while settling into stride near the inside, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve his placing while never proving a real menace. GIBBY'S TORNADO, bumped from behind by STORM CROSSED at the start while losing his path to AMAZING BUD, was righted to track off the flight racing to the turn, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch but never mounted a serious challenge. RIGGAN broke inwards exchanging contact with WATTS FERRY at the start, shifted out under pressure in the opening quarter making some contact with FIRST GUESS while being urged to terms with the pacesetter, chased the leader into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch when failing to gain even terms with that foe. STORM CROSSED, bumped soundly, then forced into GIBBY'S TORNADO, was taken in hand just after the start, continued outside a rival into the bend but never gained contention. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF STORM CROSSED LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF AMAZING BUD WHICH WAS DISALLOWED.
