Footnotes

WILLCOX INN secured a contending position outside a rival in the second flight in the opening stages tracking the pacesetter in hand from just out of striking distance, lost some position to that foe entering the backstretch, moved readily to wrest command in the third quarter when given his cue approaching the far turn, shook clear on his own courage racing through the far turn and maintained his advantage to the end under firm left handed prompting. SUNTRACER settled outside a rival in the opening half, steadily gathered momentum entering the far turn while switching off the inside, swung six wide racing into upper stretch and made solid progress to prevail for place honors. DERBY KITTEN settled into stride along the inside in the opening half, commenced his advance entering the far turn, was fanned seven wide racing into the stretch but made steady progress to late stages to edge a rival for a share. CHALICE, unhurried tracking off the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, continued unhurried to the second bend, saved ground to upper stretch while being urged to gain position, shifted off the inside nearing midstretch and was just outfinished for a share. CLOSE ALLY reserved off the second flight while shifting outside a rival racing into the first turn, made some progress three deep between foes, lost some position when caught in tight quarters entering the far turn, then continued evenly between foes to late stages. ZOE BEAR was urged to dictate the pace on a clear margin into the first turn, opened a substantial margin racing into the backstretch while resisting his rider's attempt to rate his speed, was roused to chase the winner after losing the lead to that foe racing along the inside on the far turn but emptied out leaving midstretch. TWOJOHNSANDAJACK, off a step slowly, angled to the inside, continued unhurried for six furlongs, shifted out to race eight wide through the stretch but made no impression on the leaders. CANNON HILL (IRE) was a brief factor tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight racing into the backstretch, continued in close quarters between foes into the second bend but quickly emptied out racing through the far turn. FOREST MOUSE, reserved near the inside early, shifted out entering the backstretch to advance to contention four deep between foes, made a brief bid in that path after six furlongs but gave way abruptly on the second bend. LIL BIT O'FUN, unhurried early, shifted outside foes racing into the backstretch, made brief progress five deep racing to the far turn but stopped abruptly after six furlongs.
