Footnotes

HONOUR FIRST was urged to secure a clear advantage from the break, set the pace along the inside racing through the bend, shifted out while being roused to maintain her advantage, drifted out markedly in the final furlong and was fully extended to hold safe the challenge of MICHALINA under pressure. The latter tracked the pacesetter between foes in the second flight, continued with a steady bid to gain second after a half, challenged inside the pacesetter leaving the furlong marker and was gaining late while shifting out under pressure. LUCKY LASSIE tracked the leaders along the inside just off the second flight early, saved ground on the bend and continued evenly into the stretch while finishing on even terms with a rival for a share. SECRET GLITTER broke awkwardly while hitting the gate, settled into stride, saved ground on the bend while steadily gaining contention, shifted off the inside near midstretch and continued to make mild progress to the end to gain even terms with a rival for a share. POPULAR DATE switched outside foes in the opening stages while gaining a position in the second flight, raced four wide through the turn while being urged to challenge, then drifted out racing through the stretch while giving way. PEARL RING stalked just outside the pacesetter in the opening stages, continued three deep between rivals as part of the second flight on the turn and steadily faded entering upper stretch. WILD ABOUT BOYS broke slowly losing position to the field and never seriously menaced.
