CHEROKEE LORD hopped at the start, then was bumped by MASTMAN, was quickly righted to gain terms with a rival on the pace in the opening furlong, attended the leader's tempo in hand racing into the bend, readily wrested command when given his cue entering upper stretch, then made the balance of the pace under firm prompting and some right handed encouragement. STIG'S DEPUTY, reserved three deep in the second flight in the opening stages, shifted outside foes to race four wide on the turn gathering momentum, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to prove best of the others. MASTMAN broke inwards bumping the eventual winner, was righted to gain a position along the rail tracking just off the leaders under some reserve racing into the turn, shifted out to split foes in upper stretch and continued willingly to the end to prevail for a share. IZZY GOLDEN, forwardly placed three deep between foes from the outset, chased the leaders in that path racing into upper stretch and finished evenly between foes in late stages. KNIGHTFIESTER, off a step behind the leaders, was hustled to secure the lead inside foes in the opening furlong, dueled for command along the rail into upper stretch and gave way nearing the furlong marker. HOODLUM settled well off the leaders in the opening stages and offered no rally. LALO'S BABY BEAR, in close attendance to the pace four wide in the opening quarter, quickly emptied out entering the turn. WEBSTER, held up between foes in the second flight racing to the bend, continued in tight quarters between foes racing through the turn and steadily faded entering upper stretch.
