Footnotes

LOYA BIGTIME tracked just off the leaders along the inside in the opening quarter, shifted out to split foes entering the backstretch while moving to a stalking position just off the pacesetter, made a steady advance on the far turn to wrest command in upper stretch, then turned back a challenge from ROI LE ROY leaving the furlong marker under firm handling to edge clear late. The latter tracked the pace unhurried off the inside to the backstretch, angled in entering the far turn while moving to striking distance, split foes nearing upper stretch three deep, drew on terms with the winner nearing midstretch but was outfinished. HOODLUM tracked just outside the pacesetter as part of the second flight to the far turn, bid three wide nearing upper stretch, couldn't match the top pair and finished evenly late. ROB YOUNG tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside to the backstretch, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued willingly. YUKAN B CLASSY TOO settled along the inside in the opening half, then made some mild progress between foes in late stages. JINGLE JANGLE was reserved well off the pace to the far turn, then passed some tiring rivals. TIO CHENCHO tracked the leaders off the inside behind the second flight to the far turn but couldn't produce the needed closing response. CHIEF CHICAGO was a brief factor along the inside tracking the pacesetter, then steadily retreated racing through the far turn. SHARP ROMA went clear soon after the break, dictated the pace to the far turn and emptied out once headed.
