GENDER MOTORS raced close up just outside, rallied in the stretch and was along in the final strides. NICKY D. TAYLOR lacked speed, split rivals while rallying in the stretch then could not finish with the winner. STOP THE VICE lacked speed, angled out four wide for the drive and rallied belatedly. SPRING OPEN lacked speed inside and found her best stride too late. GO WENT GONE saved ground near the middle of the field then was being pointed to split horses in the stretch when the opening closed and was taken up and could not recover. ALL THAT'S TRUE pressed the pace just outside and tired. SHE'S CRAFTY set the pace inside while pressed and tired.
