MORE ANON moved to the fore along the inside soon after the break to dictate the pace in hand on a clear margin racing to the far turn, then held sway to the end under steady left handed pressure. HORVAT CLAN was rated just off the second flight racing three deep in the opening stages, continued in that path entering the second bend while making steady progress, shifted in entering upper stretch while being roused to challenge the leader but couldn't gain even terms with that foe. CHARLIES SWELL, reserved between foes just off the second flight racing to the second bend, shifted out to bid four deep between foes in upper stretch and continued with interest to edge several rivals for a share on the wire. KID CHIC, within striking distance in the opening stages, shifted in to the rail entering the first turn momentarily impeding MY JOKESTER, tracked the pacesetter under light rating inside a rival as part of the second flight racing into the far turn but lacked the needed closing response. DALAXY settled outside a rival in the last flight racing to the backstretch, was fanned widest on the backstretch, continued outside foes through the second bend, was fanned five wide racing through the stretch but continued with an even effort while being just outfinished for a share. SILVER ROCK STAR, reserved along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out entering the backstretch to gain a position just off the second flight while pulling a bit against restraint, continued three deep between foes racing through the far turn and lacked a closing response. MY JOKESTER was guided to the rail soon after the start while under rating in the opening stages, steadied off a rival nearing the first turn, saved ground throughout but never mounted a serious challenge. CERTAIN SWAGGER angled inwards to track just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch but steadily faded between foes racing into upper stretch.
