Footnotes

MONTANA DREAM broke readily to gain terms with the leaders attending the pace three deep under light rating racing to the bend, continued with a steady bid to force the issue racing into upper stretch, edged forward to a narrow advantage leaving the furlong marker and kicked clear late under firm handling. MIRKA was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the outset, dictated terms on a narrow margin between foes racing into the bend, continued to resist the winner's challenge racing into upper stretch but came up second best. HARD ROCK GIRL tracked the leaders between foes from just out of striking distance in the opening stages, shifted off the inside racing into upper stretch but finished evenly late. MYA FACCIA BELLA tracked just off the first flight five deep in the opening stages, continued outside foes on the turn to upper stretch but steadily faded. ROMAN INNOCENCE was urged to dispute the pace inside foes in the opening stages racing into the bend, couldn't match the top pair after a half and steadily weakened nearing upper stretch. SAINT PATTY ANN was a brief factor inside foes tracking just off the leaders in second flight but retreated early.
