Footnotes

BEACH CLUB broke readily to secure terms with a rival on the pace, attended that foe's tempo under light rating for five furlongs, moved to press the issue nearing upper stretch, then drew clear in the last furlong while being kept to steady pressure. AFLEET ABACO settled in last along the inside racing to the backstretch, switched outside foes racing through the far turn while coming under pressure to advance, couldn't gain terms with the winner but gained place honors late. UPTOWN GIRL (BRZ) moved to the fore along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the second bend, briefly resisted the winner's bid but yielded in upper stretch. ANYONESHOME tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight in the opening half, angled to the inside on the far turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch to bid between foes but had no late kick. ART OF DECEPTION, pulling a bit outside foes tracking three deep in the second flight, lodged a brief bid in that path entering the far turn but quickly flattened out nearing upper stretch. BACARELLA tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch but dropped out of contention early.
