**Footnotes**

MONTANA KID was reserved well off the second flight near the inside in the opening half, saved ground on the second bend steadily drawing into contention, shifted out entering upper stretch to split foes four deep and produced a steady late response to just edge DOMAIN'S RAP in time under pressure. The latter tracked the pace inside foes under reserve as part of the second flight, shifted out nearing upper stretch to bid for command, gained the advantage in late stages and just failed to contain the winner. REAL POWER, reserved between foes in the opening half, made steady progress splitting foes just off the inside racing into upper stretch and just edged a rival for a share on the wire while closing the gap on the top pair. MY EX moved to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin to the second bend, was roused to gain a clear advantage racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum. FIRE CLOUD tracked off the second flight outside foes under light rating in the opening half, moved to contention three deep between foes on the far turn, was caught in some traffic nearing upper stretch but continued with interest between foes to gain position to the end. ROI LE ROY settled into stride near the inside early, shifted out nearing the far turn gathering momentum, circled rivals five wide racing into stretch to gain contention but had no final kick. STRIKING HIGHT settled into stride along the rail racing to the backstretch, then saved ground throughout in an even effort. COPUS worked his way to the rail early gaining a position just off the pacesetter, was urged to prompt the leader racing into the far turn and steadily faded

into upper stretch. BIG BAD MIKE tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight, lodged a brief, four wide bid nearing upper stretch but quickly emptied out. MILITARY LEGEND tracked off the second flight outside foes racing to the backstretch and never seriously menaced. FEELS LIKE FLYING was urged to gain a position between foes in the second flight, continued under pressure into the second bend and came up empty in the drive. DUSTINCASE was a brief factor racing three, then four wide into the backstretch and emptied out early.
