FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. Nominations close Friday, July 5, 2013 with no fee. A Supplementary Nomination of \$500 may be made on Wednesday, July 10, 2013 which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$100 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start, with \$65,000 added; after payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHT: 122 lbs.

Non-winners of \$50,000 in 2013, allowed 3 lbs.; \$35,000 once or \$20,000 twice in 2013, allowed 5 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered). This event will be limited to twelve (12) starters. highweights preferred. Preference of horses of equal weight will be Highest Total Earnings in 2013. Failure to draw into the race at time of entry cancels all fees. Starters to be named through the entry box at usual time of closing. Two (2) horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest. Nominations Closed Friday, July 5, 2013 with 23.

Footnotes

PATAKY KID took up a position tracking the leaders from just out striking distance along the inside racing into the turn, made a steady advance to contention saving ground on the bend, switched out to split foes just off the inside challenging for command and prevailed narrowly in late stages under firm right handed pressure. MUPPET MAN went up to dispute the pace inside rivals from the break, dueled for command into upper stretch and resisted the winner to the end while proving only second best. RULER OF LOVE, caught four wide tracking just off the first flight between foes in the opening stages, made steady progress to bid between foes in that path racing through the turn to upper stretch but was outkicked by the top pair. BELIEVE IN KITTEN, reserved out of striking distance early, angled to the inside racing into the turn and found his best stride late along the rail to gain some position nearing the wire. NEXT SPEAKER moved to the fore forcing a rival's pace, pressed the issue between foes into upper stretch and weakened late. TAKE IT LIKE A MAN, caught five wide tracking just off the first flight in the opening stages, continued outside rivals racing into the turn and evenly in late stages. BAMBAZONKI tracked off the first flight between foes racing into the turn but emptied out entering the lane. PITCH N ROLL was firmly rated stalking just off

the first flight three deep between foes racing into the turn, was urged to lodge a brief bid in that path but retreated early. DAKOTA MAC never seriously menaced. TREASURY BILL broke slowly and trailed throughout.
