**Footnotes**

INFINITE MAGIC was guided inside early tracking just off the pacesetter as part of the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted off the rail entering the lane to bid between foes, gained the advantage late and just prevailed under firm handling. ADMIRAL KITTEN settled between foes in the last flight early, swung out five wide racing into the stretch and was going well late. STORMY LEN tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, shifted out three deep on the second bend steadily moving to contention, bid for command four wide between foes in upper stretch and continued willingly to the end while being just outfinished by the top pair. PROCUREMENT tracked off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn, shifted out entering the stretch while being roused to advance between foes but finished evenly late. DORSETT forwardly placed stalking the pacesetter outside a rival in the opening half, was urged to bid between foes racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum. MORO TAP tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, was caught four wide racing through the far turn while being urged to advance but had no final kick. GENERAL ELECTION settled along the inside early, never gained contention and was vanned off the course following the race. FORMIDABLE HEART settled outside foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. MONGOLIAN SATURDAY moved to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace on a clear margin into the far turn but emptied out abruptly racing into upper stretch. TRIPLE CROSS, caught three deep tracking the leader in the second flight in the opening half, steadily faded racing through the far turn.
