ATTICO lacked speed, moved up through traffic on the final turn, rallied in the stretch and was along in time. I CAN FAN FAN set the pace from the inside, took a clear lead in the stretch and just failed to last. RELAUNCH GAL raced off the rail near the middle of the field and gained belatedly. ELWAY URAN also had a belated bid that fell short. WHITE CHOCOLATE raced close up but weakened. VIELLE SENLIS made a bid to contention on the final turn but faltered in the drive. FIDGET was never a factor. APPY EVERAFTER lacked speed and improved her position. ST. CHAPELLE lacked speed and showed little. NATASHA PUMPKIN raced near the middle of the field and tired. ALOHA CAROL gave way after a half. ZAFFRANI (IRE) pressed the pace just outside, stopped on the final turn and finished far back.
