Footnotes

CATFEINATED, forwardly placed along the inside attending a rival's pace, moved to wrest command along the rail entering the turn, gained a clear advantage and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. DEMIGOD, unhurried along the inside as part of the second flight in the opening stages, made steady progress along the rail to gain second racing into upper stretch, shifted out in late stages but couldn't gain terms with the winner. MILITARY LEGEND settled into stride along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch and made some late progress to improve position. RIVERSHIRE tracked off the second flight outside foes racing into the turn and couldn't produce a closing bid. STAR OF PARADISE tracked off the second flight between foes under some reserve early and continued evenly into the stretch. UNCLE JEEP, unhurried along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out on the turn to race five wide into upper stretch but offered no rally. PETERS ROCK, held up just off the leaders in the opening quarter leading the second flight, steadily faded racing into upper stretch. STRONG STAG was urged to the fore from between foes after the opening sixteenth, set the pace under pressure racing into the turn and emptied out abruptly after a half.
